- Entries must be taken to the Town Park Recreation Centre by **11 am** on Friday September 18. Exhibits may be picked up on Sunday between 4:30 and 6 pm

- NO COMMERCIAL MIXES, PIE FILLINGS OR ICING
- **All plates and/or pans used for exhibits (unless specified) must be disposable and all exhibits must be in a clear plastic bag or covered with a plastic wrap. Add tag to outside.**
- **Suggestion:** Temper foil pie plates for 20 minutes in 400° oven before using. This helps pies bake on the bottom

### **THEME SPECIAL**

31	<b>Heritage Red Velvet Cake.</b> Recipe to be used and included	
½ cup butter	1 tsp red food colour	1 cup buttermilk
1 ½ cups sugar	2 cups flour	1 ½ tsp baking soda
1 tsp vanilla	2 tbsp cocoa	1 tbsp vinegar
2 eggs	1 tsp salt	

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray two 9 inch pans. Cream butter, sugar and vanilla. Add eggs and food colour. Mix flour, cocoa and salt and add with buttermilk to creamed batter. Stir baking soda into vinegar and fold into batter. Pour into pans. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes. Frost or ice as desired – only the cake will be judged.
