- 5 All animals over 6 months must have original registration papers on site
- 6 Entries are to be mailed to the Show Chairman no later than September 1, 2008. Entries can be made the day of the show without a late fee
- 7 Market animals cannot be shown in dairy classes and dairy animals cannot be shown in market classes
