## General Conditions:

- 1 **Suitability of horse and rider will be considered in all classes**
- 2 **Turnout must be neat and tidy.** A riding helmet with a harness must be worn at all times when mounted
- 3 CEF rules will apply at judge's discretion. For safety regulations riders should reference Bill 156
- 4 The show will be held rain or shine and will follow class order
- 5 Lead Line Division and all Equitation classes, both on the flat and over fences, will be given prizes rather than prize money
- 6 Division Championship will be given to the horse and rider combination with the most points in each division  
Awards will be handed out after Class 16
- 7 Competitors only will be allowed free admission to the grounds. All others must pay gate admission
- 8 **Flat classes** are held in the morning with the **jumping class** in the afternoon. All classes take place in a grass ring
