## **SPECIAL AWARD**

Given by **Country Farm Seeds, Dwayne Boughen**. Highest total points in any four (4) competitions. To be presented at AWARDS DINNER.

**Field Must be Minimum Size Five (5) Acres in Each Competition. To qualify for prizes in the Field Crop competitions, contestants must enter a sample from the judged field in the respective competitions on Fair weekend.**

In each competition the winner receives a prize or trophy plus the following in prize money: 1st \$25, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$15, 4th \$12, 5th \$10, 6th \$8, plus six (6) prizes of \$5 each.

**HAY:** For a field at least 50% legumes
