- Please wash and trim all root vegetables. **Leave on 1 1/2" tops.**
- Please leave stem on all squash and pumpkins
- Please leave calyx on all tomatoes
- **For Collection classes 61-64, varieties should be named**
- It is expected that entries will be home-grown by the entrant
- Please see the Junior Competition for the **Scarecrow Competition**
