**Whole Wheat Applesauce Cake**

1 cup brown sugar

½ cup butter

2 eggs

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

2 teaspoons baking powder

1 teaspoon cinnamon

½ teaspoon ground cloves

1 ¾ cups whole wheat flour

1 cup unsweetened applesauce

½ cup raisins or golden raisins or currents

½ cup chopped apples

½ cup walnuts (optional)

Preheat oven 350 F. Lightly grease approx. 9" round or square pan. Bake 35-45 min  
Cream sugar & butter. Add eggs. Beat well. In a separate bowl combine dry ingredients. Add dry ingredients alternately with applesauce to creamed mixture. Fold in raisins, chopped apples & nuts, stir until just mixed. Pour into pan. Bake  
Ice with your favourite icing recipe.
